



ULWR Waste Approval and Receiving Policy

Last Update 6/19/2026

ALL waste streams MUST be approved in writing by ULWR prior to acceptance at any ULWR facility.

ULWR is permitted to receive and process the following 3 types of waste:

- 1) **Industrial Waste** – Industrial waste means bulk waste [tanker, roll-off, etc.] that is generated from a manufacturing process or source of any kind and is delivered to ULWR. Industrial waste includes food waste from any food manufacturing process, DAF Sludge, and grease trap waste from food processing.

ALL Industrial Wastes require a certified lab analysis of a representative sample of the waste and a fully completed waste stream profile (see attached). **ULWR will provide written notice when the waste is approved or rejected.** If approved, ULWR will provide an approval number. The approval number **MUST** be indicated on the shipping paper for each load of the approved waste.

- 2) **Municipal Waste** – Municipal waste means any waste that is generated from a publicly owned wastewater treatment works (POTW). This includes municipal liquid and solid (cake) sludge, lift station waste, digester waste, etc.

ALL Municipal Wastes require a certified lab analysis of a representative sample of the waste and a fully completed waste stream profile (see attached). **ULWR will provide written notice when the waste is approved or rejected.** If approved, ULWR will provide an approval number. The approval number **MUST** be indicated on the shipping paper for each load of the approved waste.

- 3) **Septic Tank, Holding Tank, and Restaurant Grease Trap Waste**

Residential and commercial sanitary waste sources (holding tank / septic tank) and restaurant grease trap waste sources (from restaurants only) mixed with sanitary waste are required to have individual waste approvals from ULWR.

****Every hauler MUST have a ULWR approval number to deliver any septic tank, holding tank, or restaurant grease trap waste to any ULWR facility. To receive an approval number, every hauler MUST submit a fully completed waste stream profile (see example attached). ULWR will issue a hauler specific approval number that must be indicated on the shipping paper for each load along with names of the waste sources on each load.** All of the waste sources must be approved prior to disposal. To add a waste source to your approved list email approvals@ulwr-inc.com.

(Grease trap waste from food processing is Industrial Waste – see section 1).

Failure to comply with this policy, including the delivery of unapproved or inaccurately identified waste streams, will result in the immediate suspension of your disposal privileges pending review by ULWR management.
